DATE: February 15, 2013

Over 100 students joined regents, presidents, faculty and staff for UH System day at the capitol on Wednesday. All four universities were well represented. Regents Nelda Luce Blair, Jarvis Hollingsworth, Jacob Monte, Roger Welder, Welcome Wilson Jr and Sr, Mica Mosbacher and Gage Raba and Chancellor Renu Khator, along with Presidents Bill Staples, Bill Flores and Phil Castille were honored with resolutions in the House and Senate Chambers. Groups of students and regents visited every legislative office. The four presidents were also asked to present their agendas to the Greater Harris County House Delegation.

On Tuesday, the House Appropriations Subcommittee on Education met beginning at 7:30 a.m. and Chancellor Khator and Presidents Staples, Flores and Castille presented their appropriations requests.

The Senate Finance Committee has concluded testimony from agencies and workgroups have been assigned for policy areas. The Higher Education Workgroup is cochaired by Senators Kel Seliger (R-Amarillo) and Robert Duncan (R-Lubbock. The other members are Senators Royce West (D-Dallas), Judith Zaffirini (D-Laredo) and Glen Hegar (R-Katy).

The House Higher Education Committee held an organizational meeting on Wednesday, during which they recognized the UH System students in the audience. Regular committee meetings will begin next week.


