UH and DHR Health Partner to Improve Health

The University of Houston and DHR Health Hospital System have partnered to create the UH Tilman J. Fertitta Family College of Medicine and DHR Health Medical Research and Education Center in the Rio Grande Valley. Supported by \$15 million in state funding, the center will advance research, expand the heath care workforce and improve health in South Texas.

UH Co-Leads \$25 Million Study on Pediatric Nearsightedness

UH is co-leading a \$25 million National Institutes of Health study — the first of its kind in the U.S. — to determine if a prescription eyedrop can delay nearsightedness in young children. The study is co-led by David Berntsen, Golden-Golden Professor of Optometry and chair of the Department of Clinical Sciences at UH's College of Optometry.

A Rise in the Rankings

UH climbed six spots to No. 68 among public universities in the U.S. News & World Report's "Best Colleges" rankings. UH also ranked No. 40 for social mobility and debuted on the "Most Innovative Schools" list at No. 48.

Biology Student Plays Key Role in Cancer Discovery

UH biology student Cole Woody played a pivotal role in an MD Anderson Cancer Center study showing the COVID vaccine can boost immunotherapy treatments. Woody helped validate the theory by designing custom antibodies to detect cancer-targeting T cells.
